OUR PRODUCTS

Sandvox® is a pioneering website development application that received an Apple Design Award in 2007 for "Best Mac OS X User Experience (Runner Up)." Dan and Terrence developed Sandvox after hearing from friends and family—all too often—that creating a website was just too difficult or time-intensive when using products already on the market. Sandvox was our response, and our solution.

For users who enjoy the media browser Apple includes in some of its applications but wished it were available in others, the **Karelia iMedia Browser** gives direct, convenient access to personal libraries of photos, audio, video, and bookmarks from any Mac application. The Karelia iMedia Browser is accessible from either the dock or menu bar, and is completely plugin driven. Because of its plugin architecture, the Karelia iMedia Browser is completely extensible for media types and data sources. Free to both users and developers, it is available as open source under a BSD-style license.

In 2002, our first product, **Watson®**, was hailed as a groundbreaking web utility, and was the winner of both a Macworld "Eddy" and the Apple Design Award for "Most Innovative Application."

OUR PEOPLE

A native of California now based in the San Francisco Bay area, **Dan Wood** is the father of two children, prefers bicycles to cars, and is passionately active in progressive politics at local and national levels. His commitments to simplicity, sustainability, and fairness inform his software development philosophy, as does his belief that communication—and making communication easier for more people—is vital to a more informed, active, and productive society.
